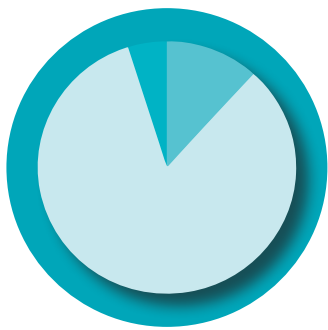

### NFSS Food Donation By Channel in Alberta



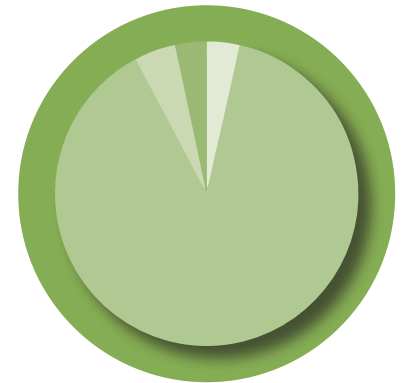

### Food Logistics

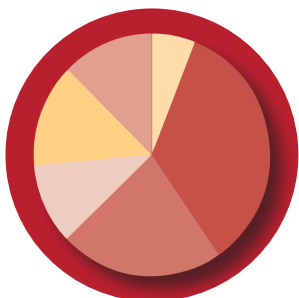
**\$50,353** in transportation and warehouse services were provided to move **509,706 lbs** of food and consumer products into various locations in Alberta.

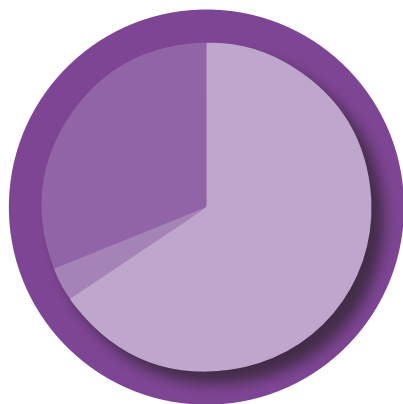
We have been able to acquire and share a diversity of safe, quality food including fruits and vegetables, meats and proteins, and cereals.

## Spotlight on our activities supporting Alberta.

Our initiatives in support of Food Banks Alberta and its 96 affiliate food banks across the province are robust and comprehensive. Financial support, donations of food and consumer products, and resources and education all combine to form assistance for our neighbours. Here are some highlights.



A total of **\$3,171,624** in funds were shared with food banks in Alberta.

Food Banks Canada National Granting Programs	<b>\$102,944</b>
National Campaigns and Individual Giving	<b>\$988,174</b>

In addition, food banks in Alberta received **\$135,286** directly from donors through nationally coordinated campaigns.

**39** food banks across Alberta participated in the Retail Food Program, **21** individuals completed the Safe Food Handling E-Learning program, **31** representatives from food banks from across Alberta attended the 2019 National Conference, **8** food banks participated in After the Bell and **36** new users registered for Ignite.
