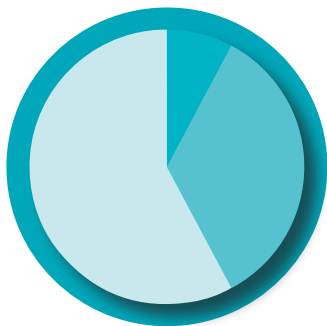

NFSS Food Donation By Channel in Canada



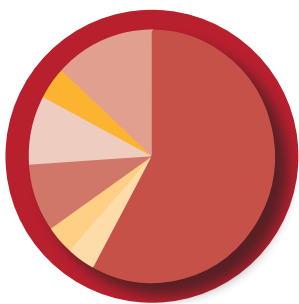

9,761,232 lbs through corporate donations of which **820,721 lbs** were fruits and vegetables.



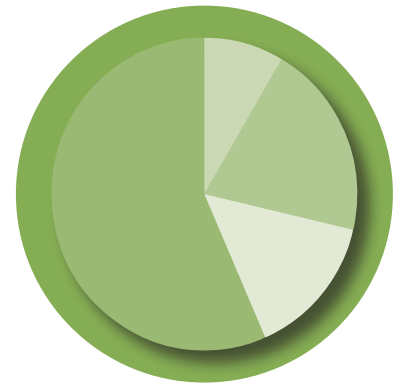

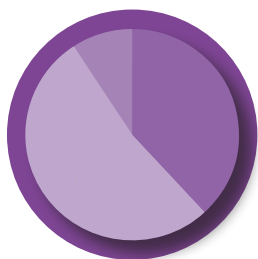

Spotlight on our activities supporting Canada.

Food Banks Canada's initiatives in support of provincial associations, the territories and the 760 affiliate food banks across Canada are robust and comprehensive. Financial support, donations of food and consumer products, and resources and education all combine to form assistance for our neighbours. Here are some highlights.

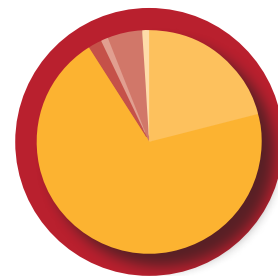
A total of **\$21,486,607** in funds were shared with provincial associations and food banks across Canada.



- Corporate Philanthropy and Cause Marketing Campaigns **\$11,317,510**
- Food Banks Canada National Granting Programs **\$1,978,216**
- National Campaigns and Individual Giving **\$8,190,881**

In addition, food banks in Canada received **\$1,342,900** directly from donors through nationally coordinated campaigns.
