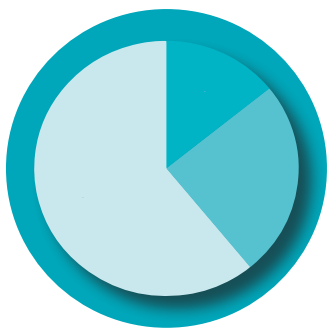

### NFSS Food Donation By Channel in Ontario



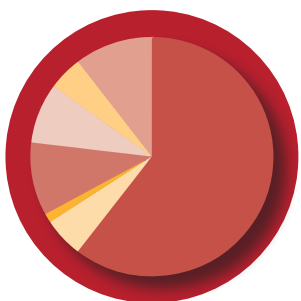

**2,057,276 lbs** through corporate donations of which **203,288 lbs** were fruits and vegetables

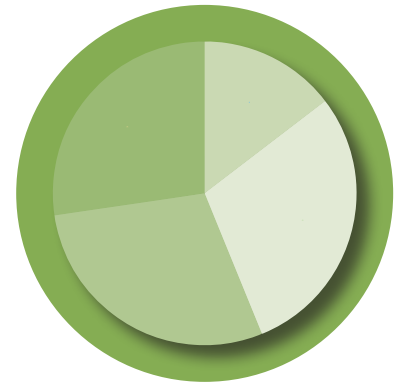

**\$86,934** in transportation and warehouse services were provided to move **2,057,276 lbs** of food and consumer products into various locations in Ontario.



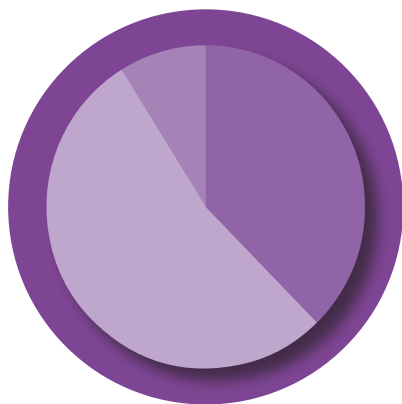

## Spotlight on our activities supporting Ontario.

Our initiatives in support of Feed Ontario and its 128 affiliate food banks across the province are robust and comprehensive. Financial support, donations of food and consumer products, and resources and education all combine to form assistance for our neighbours. Here are some highlights.



A total of **\$7,990,551** in funds were shared with food banks in Ontario.

In addition, food banks in Ontario received **\$405,606** directly from donors through nationally coordinated campaigns.

**78** food banks across Ontario participated in the Retail Food Program, **72** individuals completed the Safe Food Handling E-Learning program, **48** representatives from food banks from across Ontario attended the 2019 National Conference, **12** food banks participated in After the Bell and **108** new users registered for Ignite.
